- The Glasgow services are booked to divert via the newly electrified Shotts route in both directions.

Monday 22nd April

- The northbound sleepers go from Kings Cross this evening via the ECML as three separate services.
- The southbound sleepers operate via the ECML, but go to Euston via the NLL and reverse at Wembley.

Sunday 28th April

The Caledonian sleepers are booked to divert via the ECML in both directions with trains reversing at Wembley.
