

Engineering Work Alterations

FREIGHTLINER

The reported alterations below focus on corridors which are operated by class 90s for Freightliner.

General alterations:

Nothing to report.

GEML / East Anglia:

- Friday 2nd to Monday 5th April – the GEML will be shut between Stratford and Ingatestone. This means all electrically hauled intermodals will be diverted via alternative routes using diesel traction.
- Saturday 10th & Sunday 11th April – the GEML will be shut between Stratford and Ingatestone. This means all electrically hauled intermodals will be diverted via alternative routes using diesel traction.

There were no other alterations to report on affecting the GEML at the time of writing.

WCML / Scotland / NW England:

- The route through via Warrington Bank Quay on the WCML will be shut between Friday 2nd and Tuesday 6th April. This does mean diversions via Manchester for those trains that do run. At the time of writing, I did not identify any Freightliner services running between Coatbridge and Felixstowe over the Easter weekend due to the various closures.

There were no other alterations to report on affecting the WCML at the time of writing.

DB CARGO

The route through via Warrington Bank Quay on the WCML will be shut between Friday 2nd and Tuesday 6th April. This does mean diversions via Manchester for those trains that do run.

There were no other alterations to report on affecting the WCML or other routes that DB90s might use at the time of writing.
