NATIONAL SUMMARY

At the time of going to press, the planned strike action on the 1st April had been suspended. No further dates of industrial action were in the pipeline.

FREIGHTLINER

The reported alterations below focus on corridors which are operated by class 90s for Freightliner.

General alterations:

This month sees some disruption on some weekends and weekdays, which will result in some intermodals being revised. A high-level summary has been provided below.

GEML / East Anglia:

- 1st and 2nd April – GEML shut between Colchester and Ingatestone. Diversions and alterations apply to all intermodals.
- 9th and 10th April – GEML shut between Witham and Ingatestone. Diversions and alterations apply to all intermodals.
- 15th and 16th April – GEML shut Chelmsford to Marks Tey. Diversions and alterations apply to all intermodals.
- 30th April – GEML shut Chelmsford to Marks Tey. Diversions and alterations apply to all intermodals.

WCML / Scotland / Midlands / NW England:
