

Engineering Work Alterations

NATIONAL SUMMARY

At the time of going to press, strike action was proposed to take place on the following dates:

- 13th and 14th December 2022
- 16th and 17th December 2022

On the above dates, intermodal trains operated by DB Cargo and Freightliner will be severely disrupted. A number of planned services will not run as normal and those that do run will operate to revised schedules. See daily news and gen reports for more daily updates.

FREIGHTLINER

The reported alterations below focus on corridors which are operated by class 90s for Freightliner.

General alterations:

This month sees some disruption on some weekends and weekdays, which will result in some intermodals being revised. A high-level summary has been provided below.

GEML / East Anglia:

- 25th December route closed, no services operating.
- 26th December route closed, no services operating
- 27th December to 2nd January 2023 engineering work on the GEML between Colchester and Billericay. Diversions via Peterborough shall apply
