

Engineering Work Alterations

FREIGHTLINER

The reported alterations below focus on corridors which are operated by class 90s for Freightliner.

General alterations:

No service on New Year's Day

GEML / East Anglia:

- 27th December 2020 to 3rd January 2021 inclusive, the GEML is shut on different sections of the GEML including Colchester. Any freight trains operating during this period are expected to be diverted via Ely and Peterborough assuming any run.
- Saturday 9th & Sunday 10th January, the GEML is shut between Colchester and Marks Tey, diversions in place. No electric freights via Stratford.
- Saturday 16th & Sunday 17th January, the GEML is shut between London and Ingatestone, diversions in place. No electric freights via Stratford.
- Saturday 23rd & Sunday 24th January, the GEML is shut between London and Witham, diversions in place. No electric freights via Stratford.
- Saturday 30th & Sunday 31st January, the GEML is shut between London and Witham, diversions in place. No electric freights via Stratford.

WCML / Scotland / NW England:

Nothing to report for the WCML at the time of writing, but this circumstance can change at short notice, so please check back for any updates.

DB CARGO

At the time of writing, I did not identify any obvious engineering work on the WCML, which might impact on those intermodal trains worked by class 90 traction during January. However, this circumstance can change at short notice, so please check back for any updates.
