## NATIONAL SUMMARY

Rail strikes on the 16<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> March will impact on freight operations.

## FREIGHTLINER

The reported alterations below focus on corridors which are operated by class 90s for Freightliner.

### General alterations:

This month sees some disruption on some weekends and weekdays, which will result in some intermodals being revised. A high-level summary has been provided below.

### GEML / East Anglia:

- 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> March – GEML shut Liverpool Street to Witham. Diversions and alterations apply to all intermodals.
- 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> March – GEML shut Liverpool Street to Witham. Diversions and alterations apply to all intermodals.
- 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> March – GEML shut Shenfield to Witham. Diversions and alterations apply to all intermodals.
- 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> March – GEML shut Billericay to Witham. Diversions and alterations apply to all intermodals.

### WCML / Scotland / Midlands / NW England:

Engineering work is taking place at Carstairs for an extended period of time and will impact on intermodals worked by Freightliner for the entire month starting on the 4<sup>th</sup> March. All Anglo-Scottish intermodals will divert via alternative routes using diesel traction in March.
