## GREATER ANGLIA

### Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> May

Owing to planned engineering work, an hourly loco-hauled shuttle shall operate between Norwich and Ingatestone only today.

### Monday 7<sup>th</sup> May

A Saturday style service will operate today, but it looks like the mainline route between Norwich and Liverpool Street will be open all day.

### Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> May

The GEML will be shut between Diss and Colchester for the entire day. Shuttle services will run either side of the blockade.

### Monday 14<sup>th</sup> to Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> May

The 23:30 Liverpool Street to Norwich (1P72) shall terminate at Ipswich during the above period. Forward transport by coach to Norwich.

### Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> May

The GEML will be shut between Ipswich and Manningtree all day. Shuttle services shall operate either side of the blockade.

### Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> May

A half-hourly shuttle will operate between Norwich and Colchester with one of these extending to Ingatestone. Forward transport by coach to Newbury Park for LUL services.

### Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> May

An hourly shuttle will operate between Norwich and Ingatestone. Forward transport by coach to Newbury Park for LUL services.

An hourly shuttle will operate between Norwich and Ingatestone. Forward transport by coach to Newbury Park for LUL services.

Owing to planned engineering work on the GEML on various weekends in May, all freight will be booked to divert via Leicester, Peterborough and Ely in both directions.

In addition, the WCML is also shut for engineering work on weekends, which means the electric freights to and from Coatbridge shall be diverted via alternative routes and operated by diesel traction.
