NATIONAL SUMMARY

Strike action was planned for a number of dates during May. This is not expected to impact on the operations of class 90s.

FREIGHTLINER

The reported alterations below focus on corridors which are operated by class 90s for Freightliner.

General alterations:

This month sees some disruption on some weekends and weekdays, which will result in some intermodals being revised. A high-level summary has been provided below.

GEML / East Anglia:

- 1st May – GEML shut between Marks Tey and Ingatestone. Diversions and alterations apply to all intermodals.
- 7th to 8th May – GEML shut between Marks Tey and Ingatestone/Billericay. Diversions and alterations apply to all intermodals.
- 13th to 14th May - GEML shut between Ipswich and Colchester. Diversions and alterations apply to all intermodals.
- 21st May – GEML shut between Marks Tey and Chelmsford. Diversions and alterations apply to all intermodals.
