	Also 90004 were out but this failed earlier on in the day at Gidea Park causing much chaos - it was dragged back to Crown Point by a 47. As a result of 90004 failing, a number of sets with 90s were stepped up including 90003 and 90006. A fresh set came out of Crown Point to replace 90004 for the 18:00 NRW-LST which had 90007 in charge.
	Moreover, due to the above, the 18:20 LST-NRW was worked by an 8-Car class 321 - it is unclear at the time of writing if this went back ecs or if it worked the 22:00 NRW-LST (which often happens when a unit works to Norwich)

The missing diagram from the above list is 1p04 - this was performed by an 8-Car class 321 following the failure of 90004 the day before. The units remained out all day today until they arrived at Norwich off the 16:30 LST-NRW.

The units were replaced by 90003 on a set of stock, and the units went back ecs to Colchester. This means that we have a full service spec of stock again. The 22:00 NRW-LST should be a 90 tonight
